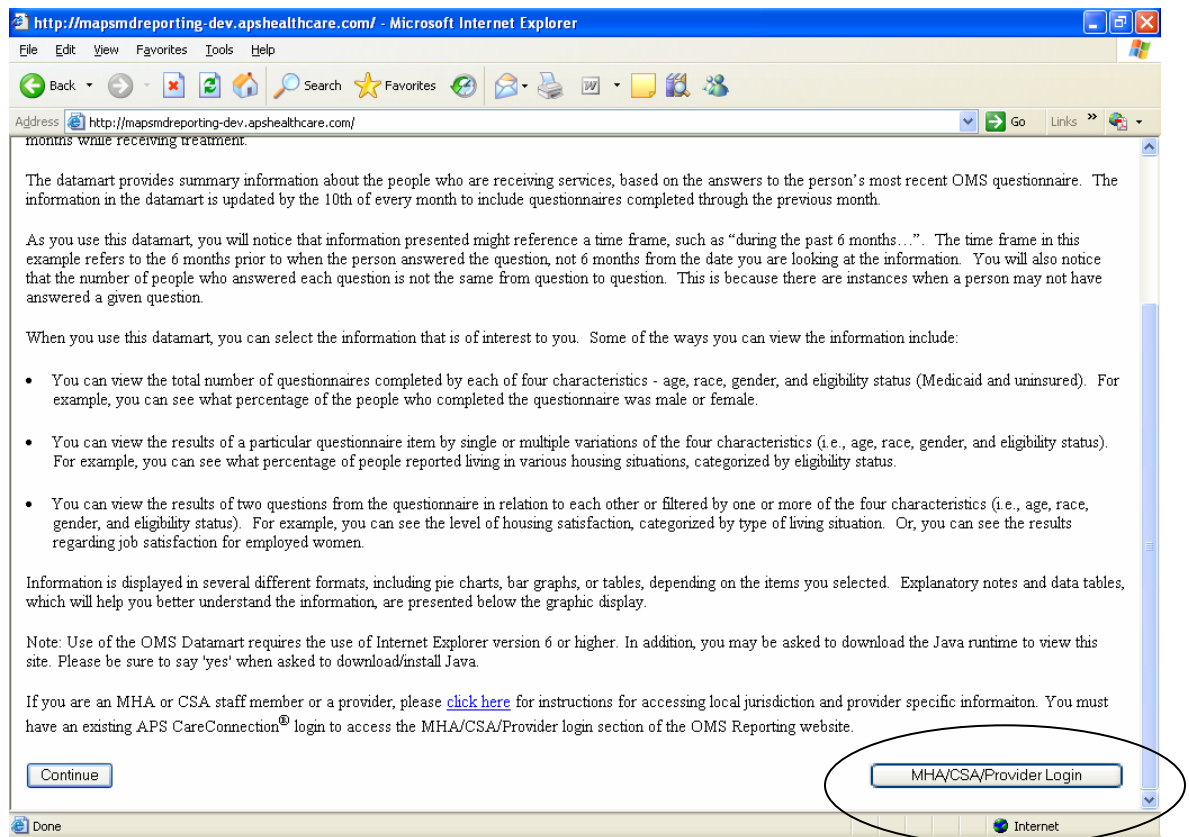


INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACCESSING CSA AND PROVIDER SPECIFIC OMS DATA

CSA staff and PMHS providers who are participating in the Outcomes Measurement System (OMS) can now access OMS data that is specific to their local jurisdictions and programs.

1. Go to <http://mapsmdreporting.apshealthcare.com>.

2. Click on **MHA/CSA/PROVIDER LOGIN** on the bottom right of the “Welcome” page.



3. Enter your APS CareConnection® User ID and Password.

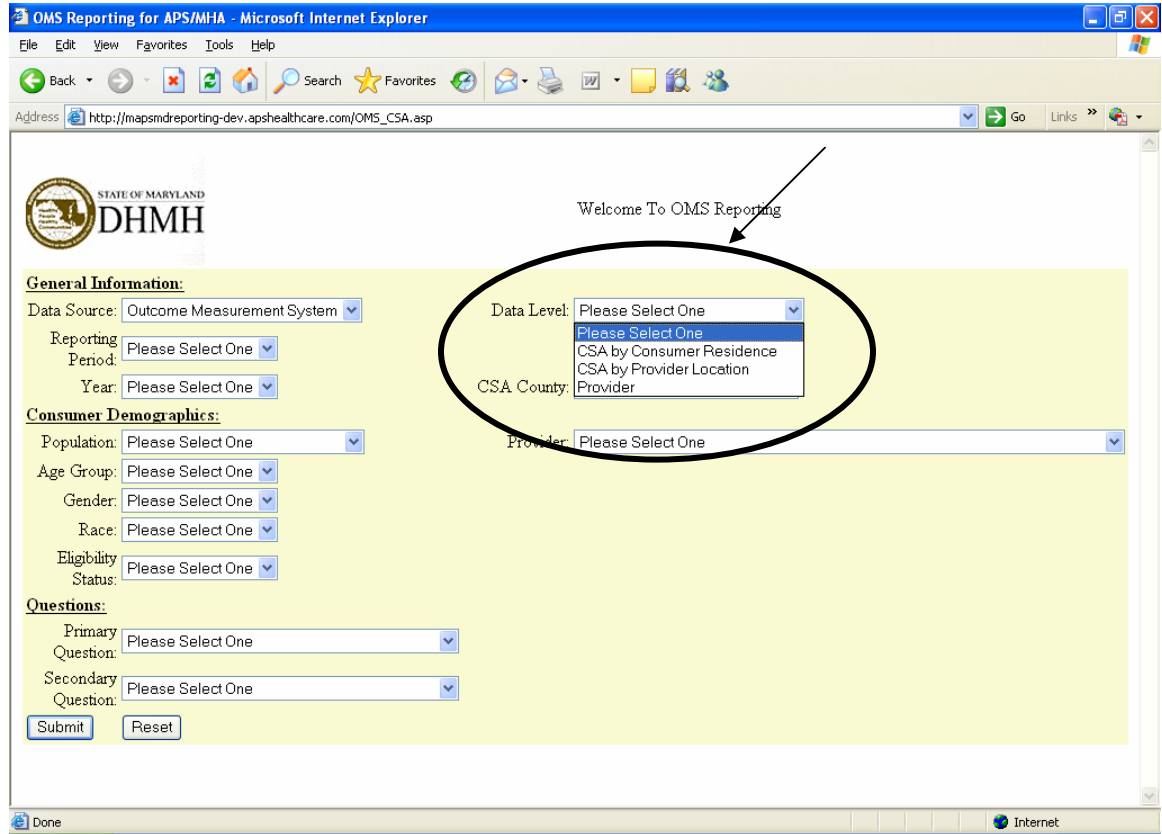

5. Select a “Data Level” on the right side of the screen.



“CSA by Consumer Residence”: All OMS consumers residing in the CSA’s county, regardless of where the consumers are receiving services.

“CSA by Provider Location”: All OMS consumers served by all the provider practice locations within the CSA’s county, regardless of where the consumers reside.

“Provider”: All OMS consumers served by the specific provider that was selected.

6. Select a “CSA County”.

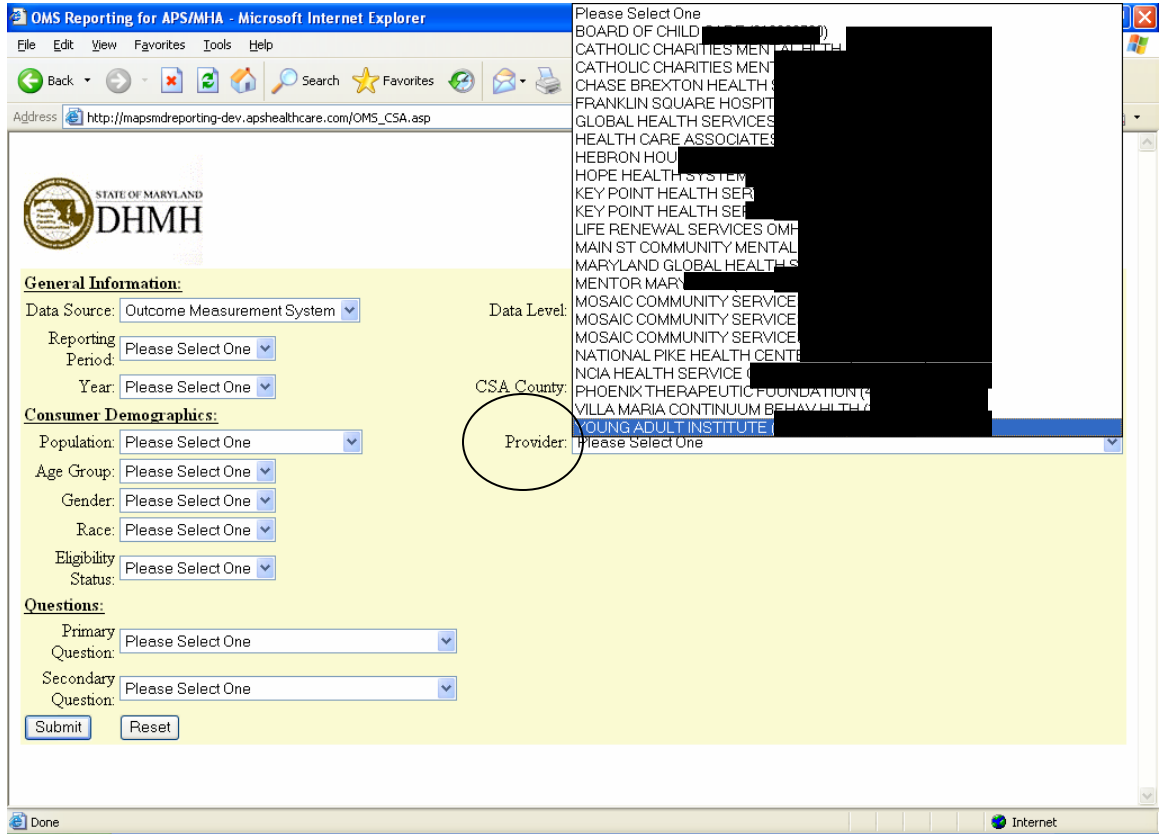

A CSA will be able to view its own aggregate data and data, specific to each provider in its jurisdiction.*

A provider will be able to view CSA aggregate data for the jurisdiction(s) in which it is located.

**Mid-Shore Mental Health Systems, Inc. can access data by each of the five counties within its jurisdiction or as a total Mid-Shore CSA aggregate.*

7. If provider specific information is desired, select “Provider”.



CSAs can view provider practice locations within the CSA’s county. If a provider has additional practice locations outside of the CSA’s county, data from those practices will not be available to the CSA. However, the data from consumers residing in another CSA county, who receive services at a practice location within the requesting CSA’s county, is available to the CSA.

A provider can view its own aggregate practice information or practice site-specific information based on its Medicaid provider numbers. A provider cannot view data of another provider (e.g., Baltimore County Provider A cannot view the data of Baltimore County Provider B). However, both Provider A and Provider B can view Baltimore County CSA aggregate data.
